Tournament Rules

1. Players will start this event with 10,000 tournament chips.
2. On-Site Registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 9. No refunds.
3. \$70 Buy-in = \$50 prize pool + \$12 administrative fee + \$8 staff gratuity. Option 2: \$50 prize pool + \$20 administrative fee.
4. Approximately one (1) in every six (6) players will get a seat into \$300 Super 40s held on February 8th at 11:10am.
5. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
6. Pre-purchase stacks will be live on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Alternate and late sign up will start with a fresh stack.
7. Players may only forfeit their stack during the end of registration break to re-enter with a full stack.
8. Levels will last 15 minutes each.
9. This tournament is scheduled for one day. The Tournament Director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, the start and stop time, and the level lengths.
10. A redraw at final table 9 or at Tournament Director discretion.
11. Tournament uses Big Blind Ante. The Blind is paid before the Ante.
12. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors and/or misinformation on any website (including third parties) or any printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim or recourse in these matters. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
13. In the spirit of TDA Rule #1, it is every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
14. Winners must show valid identification to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations; W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in).
