4. Tournament tickets are non-refundable & non-transferable.
5. Pre-purchase stacks will be live on the table from the start of the tournament.
6. Levels will last 20 minute each.
7. This tournament is scheduled for one day. The tournament director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break, the start and stop time and level lengths.
8. A redraw at the final table 8 or Tournament director discretion.
9. This is an 8 handed tournament.
10. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors and/or misinformation on any website (including third parties) or any printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim or recourse in these matters. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
11. If the prize pool is over \$5,000, the winner will receive a \$500 certificate into November event.
